## **PC Repair Technician Program (100-hour, 200-hour programs)**

The PC Repair Technician Program is designed for people of all ability levels. Participants will work in a non-traditional classroom at their own level and will progress at their own pace. A facilitator will be available to assist with questions and/or provide additional instruction. In this class, textbooks used will prepare participants to take the two certification exams. Classes start every week with open lab access Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. This is an open-entry/open-exit class. 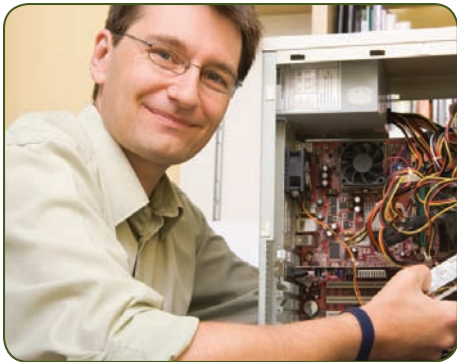

## **Computer Repair (A+ Certification) (800-hour program)**

Get certified for an entry-level career in information technology. This class provides: (1) one year (800 hours) of access to the A+ training program with supplemental study material, removable hard drive, software, textbooks, lab manual, tool kit, test preparation software and access to additional study materials as needed; (2) one year of open lab access five days per week (Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.); (3) one year of individual assistance and group presentation with an instructor who is regularly available; and, (4) four A+ Certification test vouchers. CompTIA's A+ program remains a skills benchmark that provides an entry point into an information technology career and the industry standard to validate foundational skills. The updated test objectives validate the skills needed for today's computer support professionals. To gain the A+ credentials, participants must pass two exams: the required exam, A+ Essentials 601 and one elective (A+ Technician 602, A+ Remote Support Technician 603, or A+ Depot Technician 604). Both exams can be taken at SC4. This is an open-entry/open-exit class. Participants are expected to attend a minimum of 15 hours per week to achieve the best results. Classes start every week and meet year-round. For more information, contact the Workforce Training Institute at (810) 989-5788 to schedule an orientation.
