

Computer Repair (A+ Certification)

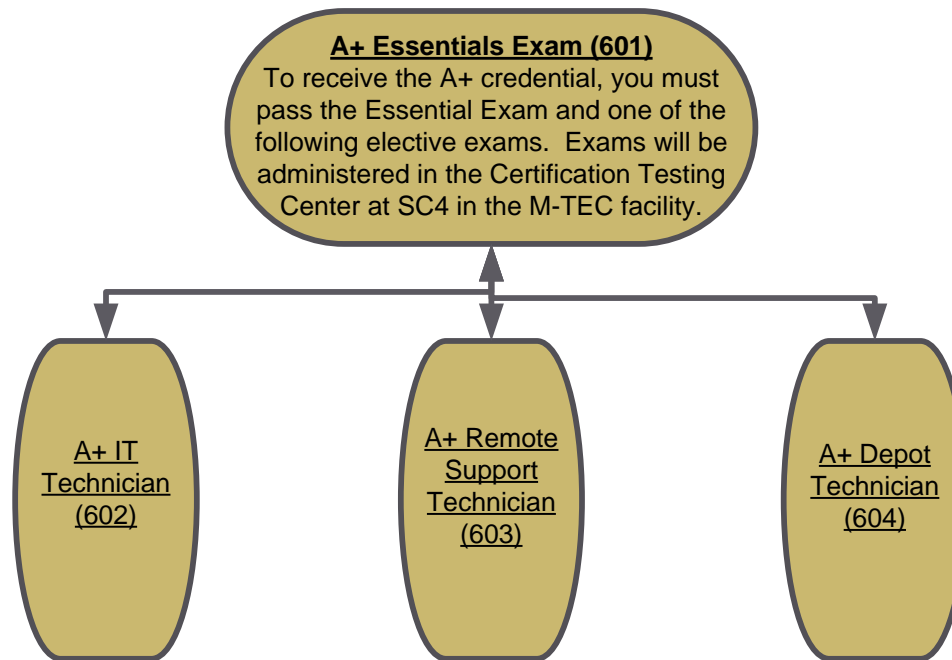

This is a one-year / 800-hour program.

The cost of this program is \$4,800 which includes:

One year of access to the training program with supplemental study material, removable hard drive, software, text books, lab manual, tool kit, test preparation software and access to additional study materials as needed. One year of open lab access five days per week, Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. at the Citizens First Michigan Technical Education Center (M-TEC) located on the SC4 Port Huron campus. One year of individual assistance and group presentation with an instructor who is regularly available and four (4) A+ Certification test vouchers are included in this program.

CompTIA's A+ program remains a skills benchmark that provides an entry point into an Information Technology (IT) career and the industry standard to validate foundational skills. The updated test objectives validate the skills needed for today's computer support professionals. This is an open-entry/open-exit class. Participants are expected to attend a minimum of 15 hours per week to achieve the best results. Classes start every week and meet year round.



If a participant does not certify, and assuming the participant has made an honest effort, a certificate will still be issued from the college indicating that the student has successfully completed the program at their one-year exit date.
