Training will cover: health and safety; Energy Star standards, ratings and audits; building shell; principles of air sealing; thermal bypass; blower doors; duct blasters and other tools; blueprints and scale drawings; energy and building codes; data collection, specs, measurements and dimensional calculations; RESNET standards; Energy Audit weatherization software; and Energy Audit careers/business basics.
