Network Administrator (Network+ Certification – 2009 Objectives) (800-hour program)

Work at your own pace in this one-year program to prepare for certification exams to earn the industry standard Network+ Certification. Get individual assistance in an open lab available from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. Class fee includes textbooks, study material, tool kit, removable hard drive, portable flash drive and test preparation materials, as well as multiple test vouchers.

CompTIA's Network+ program is designed to show that a technician is a competent networking professional. It is an international, vendor-neutral certification that proves a technician's competency in managing, maintaining, troubleshooting, installing and configuring basic network infrastructure.

In order to gain the Network credential, there is one exam to pass:

- CompTIA Network+, exam code N10-004.

Required WorkKeys assessments provided at beginning of program.

Prerequisite: At least two years working hands-on with computers. A+ Certification is preferred but not mandatory.

Convergence Technology (CTP/CCNT Certification) (800-hour program)

Work at your own pace in this one-year program to prepare for certification exams to earn the industry standard, Convergence Technologies Professional (CTP) and the Certified in Convergent Network Technologies (CCNT) Certifications. Get individual assistance in an open lab available from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. Class fee includes textbooks, study material, portable flash drive and test preparation materials, as well as multiple test vouchers.

The CCNT program consists of common-industry terms, concepts and definitions developed for network service providers. The CTP program covers three distinct areas of technology (data, telecom and convergence).

In order to gain the CTP/CCNT credentials, there are multiple exams to pass:

- CTP, one exam to pass, exam code TTO-201
- CCNT, Basic Telecommunications
- CCNT, Basic Data Communications
- CCNT, Computer Telephone Integration (CTI)
- CCNT, Local Area Networks (LANs)
- CCNT, Broadband Technologies
- CCNT, Voice over IP (VoIP) Essentials

Required WorkKeys assessments provided at beginning of program.

Prerequisite: At least one year of hands-on computer experience.
