

HESI INFORMATION REGISTRATION & DEADLINES

WHAT IS HESI—it is a self-contained computerized test. There is a calculator provided online within the test for the math portion. This test is part of the pre-admission criteria for admittance into the Nursing Programs, and the Radiologic Technology program.

The test has several sections: Anatomy & Physiology, Grammar, Math, Reading Comprehension, Vocabulary, Critical Thinking, Learning Styles, and Personality Profile. See www.sc4.edu/nursing for individual program criteria.

HOW TO STUDY -SC4 offers a non-credit HESI prep course. This 12 hour course will give you test taking tips, study strategies, subject information and question samples. For more information please visit our web site at www.sc4.edu/hesi-prep

TIME—we schedule blocks of 4.5 hours for the testing, however, most students complete the test in 2-3 hours.

WHEN TO PAY, COST, SCHEDULE (CONT.)

Keep receipt for test day. If you register via phone or mail, a receipt will be mailed.

Check dates and times before calling to make your appointment, choose alternate date/time too.

HOW TO REGISTER—after you pay, contact the Testing Center at 810-989-5555 to make your appointment. You will need to provide the following information when you call:

- Your SC4 student number
- Correct spelling of your name
- Preferred date and time for test
- Make a note of this appointment in your calendar
- If you make appointment without paying, you will be dropped from the testing schedule without notification.
- Walk-in's are not permitted

CREATE HESI/STUDENT EVOLVE ACCOUNT—create an account by going to <http://evolve.elsevier.com/studentlife/hesi.html>. You will need this account information for test day. Please use your real name so test results can be obtained by the nursing office staff.

WHAT TO BRING ON TEST DAY--

- Receipt of payment for HESI
- HESI/Student Evolve account ID and password (see above step)
- Driver's license or state photo ID

HOW THE TEST IS RUN—

- You can select the order of the sections in which to take the test. To maximize your time on the critical thinking sections, it is recommended you take Math, Reading Comprehension, and Anatomy first; then complete the other sections.
- Read all the instructions on the test before proceeding.
- Upon finishing a section, proceed to another section. Do not print out test results of individual sections; staff will print your results at end of testing.

- Blank scrap paper and a pencil will be provided. Please hand in both at end of test (even if paper is blank).
- Once an answer to a question is recorded, it cannot be changed.
- Questions cannot be skipped; you must answer in the sequence they are asked.

COMPLETING THE TEST—

- When finished testing, quietly inform staff that you have completed the entire test. They will print a summary sheet of results for you. The complete results will be sent to you by HESI/Evolve to the email address you provided.
- The Testing Center Staff are not able to provide assistance, address questions regarding test content, or interpret test results.
- The HESI exam may be taken no more than twice per year. The highest HESI score will be used for preadmission scoring.

TESTING CENTER GUIDELINES—

- Use of cell phones, pagers, iPods, MP3 players, or other electronic devices are not allowed.
- Eating or drinking is not permitted during the test.
- No hats, caps, or other types of headwear are allowed to be worn while taking the test.
- Minor children are not allowed in the test room, or allowed to wait for a parent completing a test in the Testing Center.
- No written or oral communication may occur during the test period.

APPLICANTS WHO DO NOT OBSERVE THE ABOVE RULES WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE TESTING SITE.

DISABILITY ACCOMMODATIONS--If you have a disability that would prevent you from taking the HESI exam under standard conditions, you may request special accommodations and arrangements. Appropriate documentation of disability must be provided the day of your test.

Contact the Testing Center at 810-989-5555, a minimum of 2 weeks before your scheduled test date to arrange special accommodations. **NO** accommodations will be made on test day if prior arrangements have not been made.
